## 2019 WEEKLY GAME FORMAT SCHEDULE

<b>FREE PLAY NIGHT</b>	<b>April 30</b>	<b>Season Opener &amp; Free LOE Play Night</b> – come out for a special evening of activities to entertain our 2019 members. Don't forget to pick up your registration gift! Free play for LOE members who have paid online in advance. Free play commences at 3:00pm Registration commences at 6:30pm.
<b>FEATURE EVENT</b>	<b>May 7</b>	<b>Opening Scramble</b> - the rules are simple – all ladies tee off and the best shot is selected. All ladies play the same next shot and continue this process until the ball is putted into the hole.
	<b>May 14</b>	<b>Proximity Challenge</b> – on course contests every hole.
	<b>May 21</b>	<b>Play Your Cards Right!</b> – Each person is given a playing card (spade/club/diamond/heart) at the beginning of the game. A playing card is attached to each flagstick. The player whose card matches the one on the flagstick at each hole is the only one to record their score on the team scorecard.
	<b>May 28</b>	<b>Stroke Play</b>
	<b>June 4</b>	<b>Limited Clubs</b> - You can only use 3 clubs + putter for the entire round. The club choices are the selected by each player.
	<b>June 11</b>	<b>Lagging</b> – Scoring is only based on fairway to green - closest to the hole scores 3 points, second closest to the hole scores 2 points, third closest to the hole scores 1 point, and the ball farthest from the hole scores 0 points
	<b>June 18</b>	<b>Stroke Play</b>
<b>FEATURE EVENT</b>	<b>June 25</b>	<b>LOE PRO-AM</b> – The Inaugural LOE PRO-AM will feature local PGA of Canada Professionals playing alongside teams of LOE members. Beside great company and swing tips the pros will play in a team with you and three others. The Pros will also be playing in a tournament against the other pros in the group, Pros play their own ball and LOE players play a scramble. Entry Limited to first 48 LOE players. <b>Entry Fee is \$75 per player Includes Dinner.</b> LOE participants who wish not to play in the event can still play golf this evening. <b>\$28.00 Dinner Only + Green Fees</b>
	<b>July 02</b>	<b>Canada Flag Game</b>
	<b>July 09</b>	<b>Trouble</b> - is a point scoring game in which the goal is to collect the least number of "trouble points" possible during a round. Points are assigned as follows: Whiffed ball - 4 Out of bounds – 1 Water hazard – 1 Bunker – 1 Three-putt – 1 Four-putt – 3 Hitting from one bunker to another – 2
	<b>July 16</b>	<b>Stroke Play</b>
	<b>July 23</b>	<b>Pink Ball</b> - Each player plays her own ball rotating a pink ball. Only the pink ball score is totaled. The Teams that returns with their pink ball have their names put in the draw for the evening's prizes
	<b>July 30</b>	<b>Stroke Play</b>
	<b>August 06</b>	<b>Roll the Dice</b> – At the beginning of the game each player is assigned a number between 1 and 4. At the end of each hole - shake the dice. If you shake a 1 – you use person number one's score, if you shake a 2 you use person number two's score. Shake a 5 and you use the lowest score, shake a 6 and you use the highest score
	<b>August 13</b>	<b>Odd-Even</b> - Two partner game. Decide at the start of play whose score will count for the even holes, and who for the odd holes
	<b>August 20</b>	<b>Stroke Play</b>
	<b>August 27</b>	<b>TWO PIN SPITZEE 10 HOLE 5:30pm SHOTGUN</b> – All players will play the Spitzee 10 Hole course and there will be two pins on each green, choose either to play to.

The LOE Golf League **PLAY BETTER PROGRAM** is designed to take your golf game to the next level. The program allows you to focus on 8 components of your game throughout the season.

**Schedule:** Every second Thursday commencing May 16<sup>th</sup>. The Bi-weekly program will feature a mini breakout clinic with one or more of our PGA of Canada Professionals followed by a 9 hole round of golf on one of our Heritage or Mountainview courses.

We will encourage you to play with different players every week of the program, track on course statistics (fairways in regulation, up and downs, number of putts, bunker results, greens in regulation and of course your hole by hole score).

You will learn about equitable stroke control and be introduced to the 2019 rules of golf changes introduced by the R&A this past season.

June 6	Short Game Putting & Chipping
June 20	Short Game Bunker & Pitching
July 4	75 Yards and Into the Green

The goal of the program is to experience game improvement in all areas. By the end of the 8 sessions you should be ready to establish a full handicap through the Golf Canada scoring module. You will have the opportunity to commence handicap tracking when you register for the program as a majority of your program registration fee will cover your access to the national Golf Canada Handicap System.
